#### **Role purpose**

You will manage our website and social media feeds, developing and posting information about our artistic programme, critical discussion events, a conference in 2021, cultural leadership programme and other project activity.

You will be supported by the Transforming Narratives Project Manager and Marketing Coordinator.

### **Key duties:**

- Devise and implement our digital content strategy and editorial calendar with written content, video and audio. Examples include day-to-day social media, delivering campaigns for Transforming Narratives 'season of events', conference, open calls, leadership programme
- Take responsibility for volume and quality of content across all digital channels including the Transforming Narratives website, newsletter, and social channels (Facebook, Twitter and Instagram)
- · Review and lead how we can maximise impact with project partners
- Analyse content performance including users' numbers, engagement metrics, etc. Use this information to test and develop content ideas.
- Provide guidance for the Transforming Narratives Administrator, who will support on social media marketing
